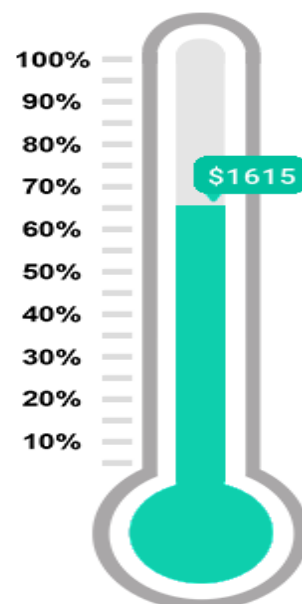

Visit the website www.helpnotharmcanada.ca to e-mail your Member of Parliament (MP), asking for their support of Bill C-218 (The Right to Recover Act), which would amend the Criminal Code to prevent assisted suicide/ euthanasia – known as Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD) -- from being provided when mental illness is the sole underlying condition.

Without this change, medically-provided euthanasia will be available for those suffering from mental illness alone beginning in March 2027.

"For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made..."

Many Canadians have heard these inspirational words from Ps. 139. Yet, many Canadians keep silent when well over 100,000 babies are done away with through abortion every single year in this country.

It is left to committed Christians and people of good will to speak on behalf of those with no voice. The group called Right Now has been working in many ways to stop this Canadian holocaust.

One way is to elect pro-life politicians. Another way is to give a majority of the present politicians something they will agree with.
